



Slice of Paradise

Though it resides in a European-style villa, this Miami bath suite stops short of going all-out traditional. Instead, the soothing space lends a modern twist to classic style with a relaxed vibe inspired by the lushly landscaped courtyard it overlooks.

Bringing a touch of the gardens inside involved a twofold approach. First, the designers capitalized on the views with a set of French doors and a pair of tall windows, including one in the shower. Then they brought the natural hues found outside into the bath—albeit in the form of a muted, neutral color palette of soft greens, linens, and silvers. Seafoam green paint topped with an iridescent glaze dresses the walls, providing a splash of color against prominent, crisp white trim. Underfoot, matching green-and-white tiles form a checkerboard pattern.

Once the views and hues were in place, it was time to bring in the amenities. The most important addition: a sculptural soaking tub perched in front of the French doors that overlook the garden. A crystal chandelier suspended
